How to Make a Simple Dandelion Frame & How to Paint with Dandelions

You only need a few supplies and can feel great about reusing cardboard for this simple nature craft. Supplies include; Dandelions, Cardboard - Repurpose old cardboard pieces, Tape, Scissors, Pencil and Paints.

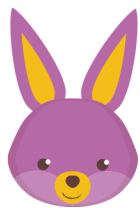
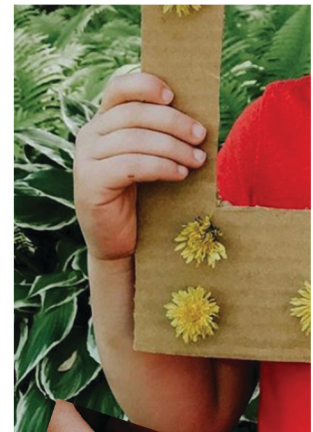
Step 1:
Cut a frame out of cardboard (similar to a photo frame).

Step 2:
Poke holes through the cardboard with a pencil.
Make sure the holes are big enough to fit the stems of the dandelions.
Your little ones will be working their hand eye coordination by pushing the dandelions through the holes.

Step 3: Tape the stems to the back of the cardboard.

Step 4: Bonus Time! Use can also paint your frame by using dandelions as paint brushes and drip the flowers into paint. The effects are really lovely, especially when you stamp different colours together.
