
ACTIVITY: MAGIC WANDS

Magical Wand Sticks

Great activity for spring with many natural resources on the ground. This activity is simple but works so well and can be extended in many ways, especially with storytelling, folklore, seasons and celebrations and types of wood. It can also be great for developing emotional literacy by thinking about the things we would wish for.

HOW TO:

Wrap wool or cord around a stick! It's very easy for little ones to do on their own, maybe just with a bit of help to tie a knot.

MATERIALS: Twigs, wool or cord, natural resources like leaves, feathers or seed pods. Just get your twig, tie the wool on and start wrapping holding your feather or leaves in place with the wool. Then let your little ones have lots of imaginative play creating magic!



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
